

Clipboard calendar

Major Steps -

- i. Place decorative paper on back of clipboard and trace pattern of board. Cut out traced pattern of paper.
- ii. Glue backing onto clipboard using decoupage.
- iii. Print the names of each month on complimentary paper (fitting 4 months/8½x11" paper) with computer. Cut each one out, making them 2x11".
- iv. Cut 1" strips of chipboard totaling 42" that will make 1x1" chipboard squares. (do not cut individual squares out at this time until you have covered chipboard with paper.
- v. Glue varied coordinated paper on the 1" chipboard strips with glue stick.
- vi. Cut out 1" squares of covered chipboard.
- vii. Add numbers to each square (up to 31), leaving 4 blank. Use the remaining 7 to identify day of the week with letter stickers.
- viii. Measure 7 equal spaces/row on the clipboard, making sure to have 7 rows. The first row will be for the days of the week.
- ix. Attach Velcro dots on back of each square and onto the clipboard in organized rows of 7 spaces. Put calendar together.

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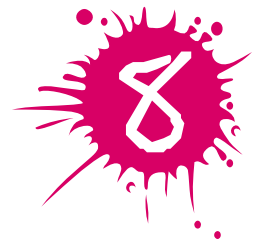
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
