Re: Change in Policy

I have notified the students of our policy regarding earned grades.

Consistent with the School of Allied Health Professions policy, the Department of Occupational Therapy has established that no more than 12 credit hours of "C" grade may be counted toward a degree.

The requirement that MOT students currently on special student status must complete the first two semesters of the program with final grades of at least 'B's' in all courses in order to be placed on regular student status, also has been changed. These students on special status, must now have a cumulative average of "B" with no more than a total of "C" grades in 12 credits by the end of the summer semester in order to be placed on regular student status.
