- Dr. Dugan talked about the importance of open communication between students and staff to create an environment that let students be successful and satisfied with their time at LSUHSC
- Secretary and Social chair openings
  - Described each duty's roles and responsibilities
  - Anyone interested in filling these roles (East spoke up about filling Secretary if need be, Riley spoke up about Social Chair)
  - Will hold an election in the near future
- Meeting availability
  - Will put out poll amongst members to find best days to hold more meetings
  - Usually meet as needed based upon events and information that needs to be discussed, but Dr. Dugan wants us to meet and communicate maybe more to grow together as "Allied Health," but also to improve our skills as future professionals

  - Tech fee meeting
    - Big part of the committee
  - o Job fair put on in the fall in the past, but not the best for people in clinical rotations
    - Discussed may move to dual attendance (in-person and zoom)
    - Discuss in the future whether or not this is something that benefits the students
  - o Family Day

- Dr. Dugan just explained the concept of Family Day (family comes to meet faculty and see how the programs work together to care for a patient as well as individual Faculty/student run booths showing what day-to-day life looks like for each program)
