Looking ahead, I am particularly interested in advancing research in several key areas: emotional regulation interventions for children in community settings such as schools and after-school programs; trauma-informed occupational interventions for children with disabilities in collaboration with community partners; and feeding interventions for children with eating disorders, focusing on a trauma-informed occupational perspective.
