In collaboration with Brittany Booth, Brittany Hall, and Stephen Yancovich, we solidified many changes to the order of the courses and introduction of new courses to ensure breadth and depth of PA studies.

2018 – present	<b>Lecturer, Course Director</b> (2019 – 2024). <u>Physical Diagnosis (PYAS 6553)</u> I lecture for 9 hours per summer semester on how the physical exam is performed which includes a review of anatomy and physiology of the organ system being presented. Additionally, the presentation includes physical examination findings that are normal or expected in the absence of disease

The systems I cover have included dermatology, head, neck, face, pulmonary system, cardiovascular, gastrointestinal system, breasts, and elderly patients. Additionally, I run laboratory groups to teach physical examination methods, which is hands and one-on-one teaching. I create and proctor all exams in this course. Lastly, I run all 3 simulations in this course with Daryl Lofaso, PhD on vitals signs, abnormal heart and lung sounds, and genital examinations.</p> <p><b>Lecturer, Course Director. Clinical Medicine I (PYAS 6555).</b> As course director I coordinate all guest lectures which are roughly 50 healthcare providers. I schedule BLS and ACLS for the students enrolled. I edit, review, and create all block MCQ exams and Written OSCE essays. I create and execute with the help with core PA faculty: Differential Diagnosis Activities, Practice OSCEs, Group OSCEs, SOAP Note grading, and simulations for Lumbar puncture and Advance Cardiac Life Support Practice.</p> <p>The individual presentations I teach in this course are Intro to EENT, Evaluation of Head and Neck masses, Dentition and tongue abnormalities, Obstructive sleep apnea, Solitary Pulmonary Nodules, Venous thromboembolism, Lipid Disorders, Cardiac Rehabilitation, Syncope, and Intro to Dermatology.</p>
2022 – 2024	<p><b>Lecturer, Course Director. Clinical Medicine II (PYAS 6556).</b> As course director I coordinate all guest lectures which are roughly 50 healthcare providers. I edit, review, and create all block MCQ exams and Written OSCE essays. I create and execute with the help with core PA faculty: Differential Diagnosis Activities, Practice OSCEs, Group OSCE development and execution, SOAP Note grading, and simulations for Surgical gowning and gloving and Cadaver Suture Simulation. The individual presentations I teach in this course are: Other Anemias, Intro to GI, Obesity Surgery, and GU Infections.</p>
