1. Visit from Dr. Greg Bagby, Faculty Senate President-elect

Dr. Bagby discussed his ideas and plans for the faculty senate for his term beginning July 1, 2007 (first meeting being the August meeting). He solicited input from the delegates present and listened to their concerns. The issue of parking for Allied Health Clinic patients was discussed and Dr. Bagby expressed his concern for the failure to resolve the issue. Other items discussed included the lack of faculty participation in some Faculty Assemblies, the loss of clinical faculty in the School of Medicine, and his desire to have the Faculty Senate recognized by the LSUHSC administration as a viable voice representing the needs and concerns of the faculty of the Health Sciences Center.
