Inventions and Patents:

All of the above simulators and challengers are documented and disclosed to the LSUHSC-NO Office of Innovation and Partnerships. Disclosures include some but not all details of a novel robotic scanning microscope, used to develop a web-embeddable virtual microscopy experience, using image stack and mosaic image interplay. Other photography innovations include two custom macro photography platforms and several playback software techniques that electronically simulate the challenges of clinical practice.
