Summer Internship – March 1st; Interviews set for 2nd week in March

Fall Internship – June 1st; Interviews set for 2nd week in June

Spring Internship – October 1st; Interviews set for 2nd week in October

Play Therapy Training Requirements

Prior to beginning a Play Therapy Practicum, Internship, or Post Graduate clinical experience, one must have completed play therapy specific training. Training may include one of the following:

- A graduate level *Introduction to Play Therapy* course from an accredited university
- Forty-five (45) hours of play therapy clock hours of continuing education from an APT approved provider, including the following areas: Play Therapy History, Play Therapy Seminal Theories, Play Therapy Techniques/Skills or Methods, Play Therapy Applications/Special Populations
- An independent study, approximately 45 hours, with a supervising faculty member in the LSUHSC Child and Family Counseling Clinic including the following areas: Play Therapy History, Play Therapy Seminal Theories, Play Therapy Techniques/Skills or Methods, Play Therapy Applications/Special Populations

Prior to beginning a Play Therapy second semester Internship or Post Graduate clinical experience, one must agree to enroll within the semester in an advanced play therapy specific training(s) within the same semester. Training may include one of the following:

- Active enrollment in a graduate level *Advanced Play Therapy* course from an accredited university
- Active enrollment in a graduate level area specific Play Therapy course (e.g. *Filial Play Therapy, Group Play Therapy, Family Play Therapy*, etc.) from an accredited university
- Enrollment in 15 hours of advanced play therapy clock hours of continuing education from an APT approved provider, including the following areas: Play Therapy Techniques/Skills or Methods, Play Therapy Applications/Special Populations

A two-semester, consecutive semester, commitment is required for Practicum & Internship experiences.
